CAMPUS SECURITY AUTHORITY CRIME REPORTING FORM

The Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act require Campus Security Authority to report crime statistics. The law defines a **Campus Security Authority** as, “an official of an institution who has significant responsibility for student and campus activities, including, but not limited to, student housing, student discipline, and campus judicial proceedings.” An example would be overseeing the student center, a person who has significant responsibility overseeing student activity, a coach or athletic director, faculty advisor.

Clery Crimes required to disclose: murder, negligent manslaughter, sex offenses (forcible and non-forcible), sexual assault, domestic violence, dating violence, stalking, robbery, aggravated assault, burglary, motor vehicle theft, arson, liquor laws, drug abuse, weapons; carrying or possessing. Also, biased related hate crimes for crimes listed above and vandalism, intimidation, simple assault, (race, religion, ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, disability).
